

Mainsail Measurement Sheet

To measure: Position boom at sailing level, high enough to clear Bimini or top of gallows. Haul fiberglass tape (Home Depot/Lowes carry inexpensive types) to top of mast until halyard stops, we will make proper stretch corrections. Measure down to top of boom at mast and aft at clew position. Next, put outhaul car where you wish for the clew of your new sail to be. If you don't have a car, mark the boom where you want the clew to be. Allow 2 - 3 inches minimum for outhaul room. Measure mainsail foot from mast (NOT tack shackle or pin) to the car pin or your mark. Measure cutback, pin height, etc... see boom drawing below
